Carluccio's to open in Bishop's Stortford

Carluccio's, the upmarket Italian restaurant chain, have signed a new lease to take the existing Café Rouge premises on number 16 North Street in Bishop's Stortford town centre.

Carluccio's were founded in 1991 by Antonio Carluccio and now comprises over 80 restaurants in the UK, with 15 overseas in countries such as Dubai, Turkey and the US. The group was listed on the AIM in 2005 before being privatised in 2010 by Dubai based investment company, Landmark Group, for c. £90 million.

Carluccio's have begun their fit out and the new restaurant will open in February 2015.

Neil Perrin, Director of Cambridge based property agents MP Real Estate who acted on behalf of the private landlord, said:

"Carluccio's offer a unique mixed retail and restaurant offer and are a genuine all day trader opening from 8am through to 11pm, 7 days a week. Their opening will add and enhance the variety of restaurants that already exist in North Street".
