ALDI buy site in Hampton, Peterborough

ALDI, Europe's leading discount food retailer, have acquired a site at Hampton to the south of Peterborough.

The 1.69 acre site is located on the A15 London Road to the south of the recently opened Vivacity Health and Fitness Centre and surrounding leisure development which includes KFC, Toby Carvery, McDonalds, Harvester and Premier Inn and is close to the Serpentine Green Shopping Centre.

Peterborough City Council granted planning permission in September 2014 for a new ALDI store of 1,684 sq m with 89 car parking spaces.

Construction will begin in early 2015 with the store opening later in 2015.

The new township of Hampton currently provides 4,500 homes built within the new neighbourhoods of Hampton Hargate, Vale and Hempstead with a further 900 homes planned. 3,100 new homes have planning consent within the new neighbourhood of Hampton Leys. Within ten years there will be a total of 8,500 homes spread across the four neighbourhoods of Hampton. Great Haddon sits adjacent to Hampton and has recently been granted planning consent for a further 5,300 homes.
