Grillstock have entered into a new 15 year lease on unit 5, which provides an area of 2,609 sq ft, at a commencing rental of £75,000 pax.

Nando's, Pizza Express And Turtle Bay are already open and Grillstock will be opening in April 2015.

Located on the corner of Hoe Street and the High Street, the new mixed use development is anchored by a new 9 screen, 1,200 seat, state of the art, Empire Cinema together with five restaurant units, 121 new private and affordable homes for Waltham Forest as well as multimillion pound improvements to the surrounding public realm and High Street.

The Scene at Cleveland Place has been developed by Hill Residential in partnership with Waltham Forest Council and Islington and Shoreditch Housing Association (ISHA).
