Planning secured for new ALDI in Holt, Norfolk

Planning permission has been secured for a new standalone ALDI store on the Thaxter's timber merchant site on Old Station Way, Holt.

ALDI have entered into an agreement to lease with Norwood Homes (Westgate) Ltd who will build the new store for ALDI starting later this summer.

The building, next to the A148 bypass, will provide a new store for ALDI of 16,415 sq ft (1,410 sq m) with 83 surface customer car parking spaces. The design will reflect the site's history with a traditional design along Old Station Way and glass around the shopfront.

ALDI Property director, Adam Ward, said: "This multi-million pound investment will provide an enjoyable shopping destination in a high-quality building that has been specifically designed for Holt."

Thaxter's were set up in 1968 on the Old Station Way site and have moved to new premises on Pippin Heath, Hunworth Road, just outside Holt.
